Dear Friends, May/June 2013

The words of Jeremiah in Lamentations 3:22-23 come to mind as I write this prayer letter.

The LORD's lovingkindnesses indeed never cease, For His compassions never fail.

They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness.

These two verses recap the covenant-loyal love of YHWH and His unfailing compassion. In this unit Jeremiah reflected upon God and the nature of suffering. Most scholars agree that 3:23 is the literary center of the book. That any had survived the tragedy of 586 B.C. was due to the loving kindness of God. The prophet's outlook was bleak, yet he tried the *uplook!* Here are some important lessons that could be learned from this weeping prophet:

- \Rightarrow Jeremiah's hope finds its restoration in the love of YHWH.
- ⇒ Jeremiah's faith is rekindled in the midst of despair.
- ⇒ Jeremiah rejoiced because YHWH was his portion.
- ⇒ Jeremiah believed in YHWH's goodness, the foundation of any man's hope.

Recently, our family has been encouraged by YHWH's goodness. These last eight months of returning to the mission field were not easy. The Lord saw fit to put us under various **trying circumstances**:

- ♦ We returned with only 19% of support.
- Sharmila's family lost their entire house in December from Cyclone Evan.
- We were without a transport for 7 months.
- It was almost impossible to make progress on my dissertation.

Nonetheless, rejoice with us for **your prayers** on our behalf have been heard. These past eight months do comprise of God's incredible faithfulness to our family! Our support level gradually grew from **19% to an astounding 51%.** Few weeks ago, **funds** came in towards our **transportation needs**. Sharmila's family has temporary **housing**. So like Jeremiah, we proclaim, "GREAT IS YHWH'S FAITHFULNESS!"

Moreover, Sharmila and I would like to **thank all of you who have made a donation last month**. We really appreciate your heart for missions and especially your desire to see the training of future church leaders in all of the South Pacific.
